

• Drive down the road to Merino to view the downtown murals and take a tour of Wisdom Rides.


• Stay for lunch at the Tipsy Cow.

• Rent a boat at North Sterling State Park for an afternoon on the water. Try a pedal boat!


• Stop at the Hot Spot Smokehouse in Peetz for a BBQ supper with the locals.

• Sleep well at the Holiday Inn Express and Suites.





Overland Trail Museum

Preserving the history of the people of Logan County and those who traveled the Overland Trail, said to be the heaviest traveled road between 1862 and 1868 during the westward search for gold and silver.





Historic structures include two barns, a general store, a prairie school, church, barbershop, 1915 stone block house, Conoco filling station, a caboose and a boxcar depot, along with an education center and several exhibit buildings. Don't miss the two-headed calf!
