

Welcome to North Sterling State Park

1. Hunting for small game , waterfowl, and archery deer is permitted during established seasons in areas of the North Sterling State Park not posted against such use, from the first Tuesday after Labor Day through the Friday prior to Memorial Day.
2. NO TURKEY HUNTING
3. Bows and arrows or shotguns loaded with birdshot are the only permitted methods of hunting. NO RIFLES.
4. Explosives, firearms, or other weapons may not be discharged within 100 yards of any designated campground, picnic area, boat ramp, nature trail, or study area except as otherwise posted.
5. Any person entering upon privately owned land to hunt without the permission of the landowner is guilty of a misdemeanor.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. Hunting is prohibited from boats. Boating is prohibited from Nov. 1st through the last day of the migratory waterfowl season.
2. Hunting from parking lots and the dam is prohibited.
3. The area north of the Dam including the Archery Range, Balance Rock, Park Headquarters, and Elks Campground is posted closed to hunting.
4. Hunting is prohibited from the frozen surface of the reservoir.
5. Target Practice is prohibited year-round except archery in the archery range

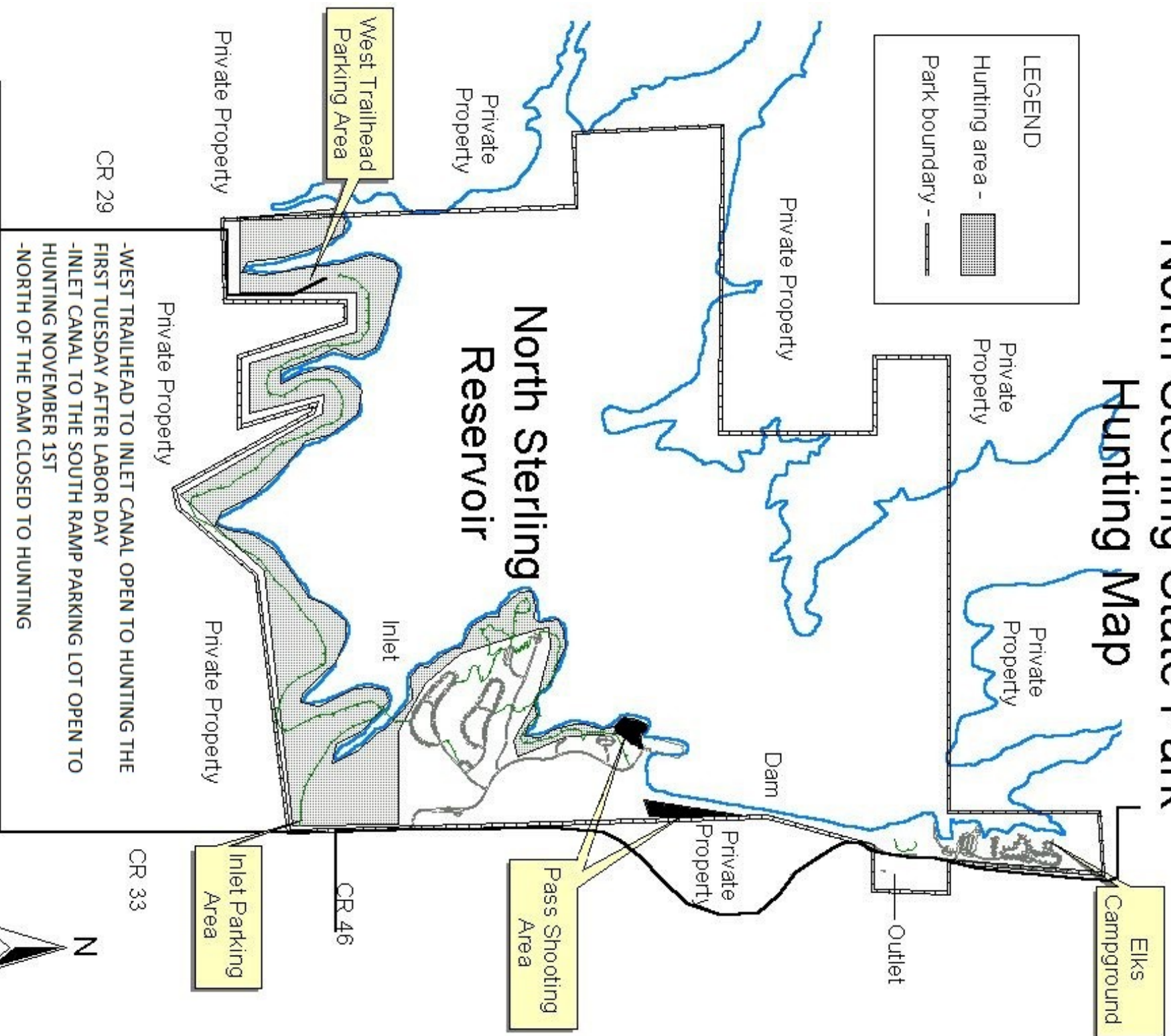
